

# Candle *of the month*

## Ship ahoy!

### REQUIRED:

DMJ-0004G	Melting urn stainless steel or
DMB-00001	Mini-Bain 1000
WAX-00102	Transparent wax light crackling or
WAX-00103	Transparent wax smooth
KLP- 06...	Preferred colour tablets or
KLP-24...	
PPB-00010	Indoor wick
MAL-00021	Floating candle cast boat
REL-00095	Adhesive wax
MGP-00010	Plaquet
VER-00211	Triangle punch
WAS-.....	Preferred decorative wax sheets

- Heat the wax to 90 °C and pour a thin layer onto the plaquet (less than ½ a litre). Use a punch to cut a number of triangles from the wax before it has cooled completely. Make sure that the triangles are at least as wide as the floating candle boat cast. Lay the wick onto a triangle in such a way that the top of the wick protrudes by about 1 cm and the bottom by somewhat more. Please note: the red tip of the wick is the bottom side. Gently press the wick into the soft wax and place a second triangle on top with a ball of adhesive wax between the two triangles. Press together firmly. Allow the sheets to cool. This will form the sail of the boat.
- Now prepare the floating candle cast. Spread a thin layer of Vaseline onto the casts. Colour the wax as preferred and fill the casts. Once the wax starts to set, add a sail to every cast. To do this, push the longer end of the wick into the soft wax until the sail rests on the side of the cast. Allow to cool and remove the boats from the cast. Use a piece of decorative wax sheet to place a little flag on top of the mast.
- You can further decorate the candle as desired. **Use your imagination!**
