- Divide the plaque into multiple sections, fill 1 section with colourless paraffin, 1 with light pink paraffin and 1 with light green coloured paraffin (1/2 a tablet per litre of wax)
- Before the wax has fully cooled, use the punch to cut rectangles from your desired colours. Immediately use a kebab stick to pierce a hole in each rectangle. Push an indoor wick through the hole and stack differently coloured sheets and decorative wax sheets – if desired – on top of one another. Place a globule of Paraffin glue between every sheet and press down firmly
- Or place a few thin rectangles of coloured wax on a sheet of colourless wax and roll them up, while perhaps covering the exterior with black decorative wax.
